OR 221 |OR 221 (Wallace Road) in West Salem, Polk County

#### Cost and Funding

Estimated \$6.3 million

#### Benefits

The project will benefit the 35,000 motorists a day that use this section of highway combined with a large number of bicycles and pedestrians.

These improvements will enhance safety for pedestrians and bicyclists, while meeting current ADA standards along this stretch of OR 221 (Wallace Road).

# Additional Information

The project will do the following:

- · Repave the entire stretch of roadway;
- . Upgrade the curb ramps to meet current American with Disabilities (ADA) standards;
- Upgrade traffic signals with yellow reflectorized back plates to improve driver visibility, and crosswalks will receive countdown pedestrian signals; and
- install rapid flashing beacons (RRFBs) and other associated improvements at five crosswalks: Narcissus Ct. NW, Lynda Ln NW, Orchard View Ave. NW, the Park and Ride north of Brush College Road and Vick Ave. NW.
