


| DESCRIPTION of REQUEST: | Council Review of the Salem Planning Commission’s Decision on a consolidated Minor Comprehensive Plan Map Amendment from “Commercial” and “Multiple Family Residential” to “Community Service Government”, Minor Neighborhood Plan Map Amendment to Community Service Government, and Zone Change from CG (General Commercial) and RM-II (Multiple Family Residential) to PS (Public Service) for properties totaling approximately 1.89 acres in size and located in the 2400 Block of Commercial Street NE and Liberty Street NE (Marion County Assessor Map and Tax Lot Numbers: 073W15AD05600, 5700, 5800, 5900, 6000, 6100, 6200, 6300, & 6400). |
| HOW TO PROVIDE TESTIMONY: | Any person wishing to speak either for or against the proposed request may do so in person or by representative at the Public Hearing. Prior to the Public Hearing, written comments may be filed with the City Recorder, 555 Liberty Street SE, Room 205, Salem, OR 97301 or cityrecorder@cityofsalem.net . |
| HEARING PROCEDURE: | <p>The hearing will be conducted with the staff presentation first, followed by the applicant’s case, neighborhood association comments, persons in favor or opposition, and rebuttal by the applicant, if necessary. The applicant has the burden of proof to show that the approval criteria can be satisfied by the facts. Opponents may rebut the applicant’s testimony by showing alternative facts or by showing that the evidence submitted does not satisfy the approval criteria.</p> <p>Failure to raise an issue prior to the close of the Public Hearing in person or in writing, or failure to provide statements or evidence with sufficient specificity to provide the applicant and Review Authority to respond to the issue, precludes appeal to the Land Use Board of Appeals (LUBA) on this issue. A similar failure to raise constitutional issues relating to proposed conditions of approval precludes an action for damages in circuit court.</p> <p>Following the close of the Public Hearing, a decision will be issued and mailed to the applicant, property owner, affected neighborhood associations, anyone who participated in the hearing, either in person or in writing, and anyone who requested to receive notice of the decision.</p> |



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
Comprehensive Plan Map



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
Zoning Map
