- \$ 56,160 Add wainscot wall protection down main hallways
- \$ 95,770 Increase generator <u>fuel tank size</u> from 24 hour capacity <u>to 72 hour capacity</u>.
- \$ 85,138 Reduce East Privacy Skin at Upper Parking Deck
- \$ 70,000 Add Leak Detection @ Patio Roof and Community Room Roof
- \$1,184,231 Total
