Seismic/Structural Upgrades:

added concrete shear walls (Library and Parking garage)

Accessibility Upgrades:

- grading of walkways and parking lot
- bathrooms
- door hardware
- stair railings and guardrails

Building Enclosure Upgrades - increased thermal performance

- roof replacement (1970s) and upgrade (1990s)
- 1970's window replacement

System Upgrades

- mechanical, electrical and plumbing system upgrades
- lighting upgrades (to LED)

Interior Upgrades:

- new carpeting
- new shelving
- new points of service / desks
- some new furniture




