THE COURT FINDS probable cause to believe that the premises and property located at the contiguous lots addressed 2792 Marietta St SE (Taxlot# 083W12C000301), 2828 Marietta St SE (Taxlot# 083W12C000500), 2832 Marietta St SE (Taxlot# 083W12C000400), and an unaddressed parcel of land identified by Taxlot# 083W12C0002200, City of Salem, Marion County, Oregon, holds evidence of violations of SRC Chapter 808 have occurred or are occurring. THE COURT FURTHER FINDS that this warrant cannot effectively be executed in the presence of either the owner of the premises or lawful occupant over the age of 18 years of age of the premises. THE COURT FURTHER FINDS that facts and circumstances exist which reasonably justify the inability of City of Salem Officials to obtain consent to enter upon and conduct an inspection upon the premises and property located at 2792 Marietta St SE, 2828 Marietta St SE, 2832 Marietta St SE, and an unaddressed parcel of land identified by Taxlot# 083W12C002200, City of Salem, Marion County, Oregon.					
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THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED, pursuant to Salem Revised Code (SRC) 4.190 to 4.230:

THE CODE ENFORCEMENT OFFICIAL OF THE CITY OF SALEM AND CODE ENFORCEMENT OFFICIAL'S DESIGNEES ARE HEREBY COMMANDED TO MAKE IMMEDIATE ENTRY UPON AND CONDUCT AN INSPECTTION UPON:

1. The premises located at 2792 Marietta St SE (Taxlot# 083W12C000301), 2828 Marietta St SE (Taxlot# 083W12C000500), 2832 Marietta St SE (Taxlot# 083W12C000400), and an unaddressed parcel of land identified by Taxlot# 083W12C002200, Salem, Marion County, Oregon, which are further described as being accessed by driving southbound on Commercial Street SE to Kuebler Street SE. Once at Kuebler Street SE, turn eastbound, or left and continue on Kuebler Street SE until reaching 27th Avenue SE. Turn northbound, or left on 27th Avenue SE. The Taxlot#083W12C002200 will be on the east side of 27th Avenue SE, or on the righthand side of 27th Avenue SE. As you proceed northbound on 27th Avenue SE, you will next come to the property otherwise described as 2792 Marietta Street SE, which runs to the corner of 27th Avenue SE and Marietta Street SE. Once at the intersection of 27th Avenue SE and Marietta Street SE, turn eastbound, or right, and you will come to three residences, the second and third east most residences are also described as the property of 2828 Marietta Street SE and 2832 Marietta Street SE. The property continues to the east past the intersection Strong Road SE, until reaching the east edge of 2792 Marietta Street SE, which has buildings along the boundary belonging to 3002 Marietta Street SE, which is on the south side of Marietta Street SE. The Property is additionally described in the photograph below. Further to inspect the outdoor landscape and exterior of any buildings on the premises, take evidentiary photographs, determine species of any trees on the premises, and plot on digital and physical maps the locations, species, and measurements of trees that have been removed so that the extent of the violations observed can be substantiated.

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IT IS FURTHER ORDERED:

This warrant need not be executed in the presence of either the owner of the premises or lawful occupant over the age of 18 years of age of the premises.

This warrant shall be served any time between the hours of 8 am and 6 pm, but in no event for a period more than 14 days from the issuance of this warrant, unless extended or renewed by this court, with a showing of good cause.

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1	This administrative warrant must be executed and returned to the judge within ten
2	days from the date of issuance, unless otherwise authorized. This warrant shall be returned to the Court certifying the day and time of execution of the administrative warrant, the names
3	of all city officials, including police officers, assisting in the inspection, the time and manner
4	of giving any notice, and whether or not forcible entry was necessary. After expiration of the
5	time prescribed by this section, the warrant, unless executed, is void.
