5. DESIGN REVIEWS

a. <u>Historic Design Review - Case No. HIS20-27 for 900 Court St NE</u>

Request: Major Historic Design Review of a proposal to construct a Vietnam War Memorial on the Oregon State Capitol grounds, individually listed on the National Register, located at 900 Court Street NE (Marion County tax lot 073W27AA00200).

The Chair opened the public hearing at 5:36 p.m. and directed staff to read the applicable criteria into the record. The Chair asked if there were any conflicts of interest or exparte contacts. Condition 1:

Should the applicant proceed with siting the Gold Star Family Memorial within the location of the existing Parade of Animals sculptures, the applicant shall ensure that the Parade of Animals sculptures are relocated to another location on the Capitol Grounds. The applicant shall submit a site plan showing the proposed new location of the sculptures for historic design review approval prior to issuance of building permits for the Vietnam War Memorial.
