a. <u>Historic Design Review – Case No. HIS21-13 for 1162 Court St NE</u>

A Class 3 Major Historic Design Review to replace two south elevation doors within the light court, replace terracotta cladding with Glass Fiber Reinforced Concrete replicas, replace the existing single pane glazing with double paned insulated glazing units, raise the 5th floor window sills and alter the 5th floor lower sashes and install security film on ground level windows and doors on the Oregon Justice Building (1930), a Local Historic Landmark, in the PM (Capitol Mall) zone and located at 1162 Court Street NE(Marion County Assessors Map and Tax Lot number: 073W26BB04700).
