## Traffic Team offers car seat clinic next week

**Salem, Ore.** — The Salem Police Department is holding a car seat clinic from 9 a.m. to 2 p.m. on Friday, September 10, 2021 at the Marion Parkade, 400 Marion ST NE.

As part of the effort to continue to raise awareness of the importance of seat belt use, officers will provide parents, guardians, and caregivers instruction on the proper installation of the car seat and how to harness a child in the seat. The carriers will also be evaluated for suitability and their recall status checked.

Participants should have the carrier seat and/or booster already installed in the vehicle, along with the manuals for the car seat and for their model vehicle, if available.

The outdoor clinic will be held on the first floor of the parking structure, closest to the Union Street side of the building.

The traffic safety education project is conducted in partnership with <u>ODOT Transportation</u> Safety.
