# 1. Call to Order, Welcome and Review of Agenda

# **b.** Bias Crime Update

Lt. Aguilar reported on four crimes and three incidents that presented to the SPD. Hamadi Jackson clarified the reporting process. People are encouraged to call the non-emergency line at 503-588-6123 unless there is a crime in progress that would suggest calling 911. The group discussed hate symbols. Lt. Aguilar spoke of the Southern Poverty Law Center, the Anti-Defamation League, and the FBI as resources to learn more.

**c. Complaints Report:** Gretchen reported one situation; she has incomplete information at this time.

# 5. Task Force and Project Updates:

- **a.** Awareness: Chair Ostrand-Ponsioen reported the discrimination survey is in the field receiving responses. Response numbers are a bit behind last year. Commissioners are encouraged to share the information as we hope many will complete. Paper copies were distributed to people who are unsheltered. A full report will be provided at the June HRC meeting by the students conducting the survey.
- **b.** Equity Asks Report: Juneteenth is now formally a city holiday.
- **c. LGBTQIA+ Intersectional Rights:** The group discussed the Equity Asks document from the HRC as a priority, and assessment of the City as a lead participant. The task force is working on the prerequisites to be a participant. The timeline will be delayed.
