2023 Legislative Priorities

- Funds for:
 - i. River Road Slide Mitigation (\$20 million, one-time)
 - ii. Peace Plaza public square (\$2 million, one-time)
 - iii. Sustain sheltering program (\$9 million annually) and Navigation Center (\$2.1 million annually), and operate sobering center (\$1 million for two years)
- Policy for:
 - i. Policy for photo radar fix to include Salem (SB 560, 2019 Session)
 - ii. Support Towing Association in effort to capture cost of future recreational vehicle demolition (similar in scope to SB 4066, 2021 Session)
 - iii. Payment in lieu of taxes
