There is a traffic tracker that has been placed on Mildred near Smoke Tree for measuring traffic speeds. Someone from the neighborhood asked Jackie to find out about installing speed bumps to slow traffic on Robins Lane SE. Jackie said that if the City was not willing to install speed bumps then it can be installed by residents collecting money.

Neighborhood asked Jackie to check into the development south of Landau on Battlecreek to see whether it is in Salem or in the county They have cut down most of the trees on that property.
