Staff News

This month, we said goodbye to Robin Saunders, Senior Library Clerk after 31 years of service. She was a leader on the team, generously shared her deep knowledge with her coworkers and formed meaningful relationships with patrons. She will be missed!

There were multiple staff training sessions in September, including fire extinguisher with the Salem Fire Department, an introduction to accessing collection data via unfamiliar software with CCRLS system staff, city Safety Monitor orientation, and a "refresher" session on more complicated circulation tasks with Robin.

Many staff were able to attend one of two Town Hall meetings with fellow city employees this month. The executive leadership team shared the details of the city's revenue shortfall and potential impacts if a new revenue source isn't found. The session included how we got to this point, why we have the short fall and how the city leadership team will work with the elected officials for a solution.

Collections

We are very excited to announce that the Salem Reporter has given the library free access to the newspaper for in-house use. Any patron who uses a catalog computer or a public computer in the library will be able to access the newspaper free of charge. We are very appreciative of their in-kind gift and know that it will be highly utilized by patrons.

We recently subscribed to the Southwest Art Magazine due to patron requests. Patrons will be able to see the beautiful photos and art in print form.

Projects and Programs

200 people attended the SPL Foundation sponsored Indian Dance Program on Saturday Sept 23. The dancers came from Chennai and Delhi in India, as well as others from Portland for this special event. Attendees of all ages enjoyed the beautiful costume, dance, and music that represented Indian culture and folklore. People from

the South Asian community, some who are not regulars to the library, showed up for the event and thanked us for having this performance. The dancers enjoyed the space and expressed their appreciation of our collaboration. Many people had glowing reviews of the performance as they left the auditorium afterward. Several people thanked the library for hosting live performances and commented that the performance that day was beautiful. One attendee specifically expressed gratitude that the library hosts events such as these for free so that all may attend, not just people with the resources to pay for performance tickets.





We had the honor of hosting the United States Navy Brass Quintet in Loucks Auditorium. Weeks before the concert, patrons expressed interest in attending. We had 115 join the audience for an evening of music that spanned from classical, to all American, and even popular Disney tunes. The performance topped the night off with "Anchors Aweigh". Afterwards, there were a number of veterans who shared their gratitude with staff and stayed to speak with the service members.





The vendor lockers were returned to due malfunctioning hardware. We hope that in the future we can locate a machine that will withstand the Oregon weather and protect material from the elements.

What we are Looking Forward to!

We are celebrating Dia de los Muertos all month long. Community members are welcomed to bring in items to add to the ofrenda. Day of the Dead (Día de los Muertos) is a holiday celebrated throughout Latin America between October 31-November 2 during which families remember loved ones who have passed. The altars are different in every culture but they are all a way for living family members to honor their loved ones who are no longer here.

By the end of the month, the troublesome front doors will be replaced by two automatic sliding doors.

We are celebrating the Freedom to Read with a Banned Book Month Display, book lists, and buttons.

Strategic Plan Updates

The Youth Services Team is working on updated Welcome videos in both English and Spanish to welcome new patrons into the library, inform them of our services and all the wonderful things they have access to with their library card.

The front doors are being updated for quality and accessibility. Current doors are too heavy, close too soon, and are narrow which make it difficult for patrons to get in and out of the building.
