Hi Ron,

The airline flights are doing quite well, especially the Burbank flights which are full or nearly full. For both the Las Vegas and Burbank flights combined the total load factor is 80% or better, so that's an excellent start two months in. I haven't received November totals from the airline yet, but in October we enplaned 1,902 passengers and deplaned 1,717 for a total of 3,619 passengers on 16 flights. That's really all the data I have to share this early on. Otherwise it is more or less business as usual, with increased security in place and even more increased security coming in the next few months.
