- SPD using intelligence led policing, currently focusing on downtown and the area north of Silverton Rd. Officers are attending vents and participating in high visibility activities.
- March focus will be on downtown, potential an additional area.
- All officers have received at least two units of procedural justice training, including implicit bias training. SPD staff have been trained as trainers of this material.
- School zone speed enforcement
 - Baseline data gathered by 'know your speed' signs that were "off"
 - focus was on Straub and Crossler (S. Salem)
 - Crossler had a large (~20%) decrease in speed.
 - Straub had ~5% decrease
