Thanks for your patience. Here are the requested updates for the West Salem Redevelopment Advisory Board.

New parks in west Salem

As a general trend, Park development timelines are extending out. It is primary an issue of capital cost – we've seen construction costs escalate over the past few years; however, the City also has a General Fund revenue issue effecting Parks Operations and new parks need to be maintained and operated.

The next park in west Salem scheduled for a major development project is Eagle's View, a neighborhood park located at 451 Eagles Wing St NW. I anticipate construction will start in 2028 or 2029, based on the

funding forecast included in the Capital Improvement Plan.

Park predevelopment efforts include the following.

 Through the City's contract with Friends of Trees, volunteers planted approximately 45 trees at Eagle's View Park this past fall.

A similar tree planting event will be held at Ellen Lane Park on February 10th.

Parks staff will be starting a riparian restoration effort at Eagle's View Park this year.

Parks Planning staff are actively exploring opportunities to acquire a new park property, to be located east
of Wallace Road NW. This acquisition would fulfill a need identified in the Comprehensive Park System
Master Plan as Proposed Neighborhood Park #30 (NP 30). For more context, see the attached map.

Other Park Improvements

Thanks to the voter approved Safety and Livability Bond passed in 2022, the City has a ten-year plan to upgrade existing parks throughout Salem. The following is a list of projects in west Salem.

- Brush College Park Playground Rehabilitation and Equipment Replacement
- Orchard Heights Park Picnic Shelter Development

Restrooms at West Salem Park

West Salem Park is classified as a Neighborhood Park, meaning the City plans for it to serve nearby residents with local access to basic recreation resources. While permanent restrooms are not normally provided in neighborhood parks, West Salem Park is one of several older parks that have one. In order to provide a consistent level of service across the City, the 2013 Comprehensive Park System Master Plan recommends removal of the restroom at the end of it useful life and, following removal, deployment of a season chemical toilet as needed.

In 2023, the West Salem Neighborhood Association's Park Chair, Linda Bierly reached out to the City and requested a meeting with several west Salem community partners. In that meeting, community partners shared a desire to replace the restroom and a wiliness to help fund raise. In acknowledging the value the community

places on the summer concert series hosted at the park, Parks Planning suggested that the City pursue a grant to fund approximately half of the cost to replace the structure once community partners raise the other half of the cost, which would match a grant aware to fully fund the project.

City staff have nearly completed a cost estimate, which community partners need to set a fundraising goal.
