Salem Crime Statistics: 15 Years in Review


- The crime counts are tallied from our Records Management System (Mark 43) using the standards defined by the FBI's "Uniform Crime Reporting" program:
 - Crimes against persons (Homicide, Aggravated Assault, & Rape) are tallied based on the number of victims of the crime
 - Motor Vehicle Thefts are tallied by the number of vehicles stolen
 - Other crimes against property (Arson, Burglary, Larceny, & Robbery) are tallied by the number of incidents
- In 2020 the Salem Police Department adopted the Federal NIBRS crime definitions and stopped using the Oregon definitions (ONIBRS) when reporting statistics to the FBI Uniform Crime Reporting program.
- Specific crimes included in the Violent Crime Statistics include: Homicide, Rape, Robbery, and Aggravated Assault
- Specific crimes included in the Property Crime Statistics include: Burglary, Motor Vehicle Theft, Larceny (All), and Arson
- Population data is obtained from the Portland State University Population Research Center
 - For most years, the population is an estimate calculated by the Census Bureau. In 2020 the U.S. Census occurred, and the population was corrected to match the actual count for that year
- The crime rate is calculated per 100,000 residents. This allows for a more accurate comparison from year to year, correcting for population growth
- The expected range is calculated by using two standard deviations from the average. This method produces an expected range with 95% accuracy
- It is possible for crime counts to change from previous years due to ongoing activity on cases (changes from last year are highlighted in blue)
- Graphs presented in this document show actual count numbers and rates per 100,000 population compared to a linear trend line













RATE: VIOLENT CRIMES PER 100,000 POPULATION




















Salem Crime Statistics: 15 Years in Review RATE: PROPERTY CRIMES PER 100,000 POPULATION






