Goals

Action

Should the West Salem Redevelopment Advisory Board (WSRAB) allocate \$30,000 from the small projects opportunity fund for the Salem Public Art Commission (SPAC) to select an artist and sculptural art for the art pedestal constructed on 2nd Street NW based on the following project values and design goals?

Project Values:

- A) Uniqueness create interest in the location and the broader West Salem district
- B) Sense of place abstract representation of West Salem history, evolution, and community

Design Goals:

- 1) Culturally and physically enrich the built environment
- 2) Sculptural art that meets City of Salem Public Works art mounting specifications
- 3) Sculptural art built to City of Salem Public Works standards for safety, security, durability, and vandal resistance
- 4) Encourage social connection, interaction, and promotion
- 5) Creative representation of West Salem
- 6) Visually interesting
- 7) Welcoming

Background

There is ongoing community interest in the expansion of Salem public art. An art pedestal, like the downtown locations, is included in the construction of 2nd Street NW. The next step is to provide information to SPAC so they may proceed with the selection process. Public art on 2nd Street NW has been discussed by WSRAB in November 2023, April 2024, and May 2024.

Next Steps

If approved, project values, design goals, and mounting specifications will be provided to SPAC. SPAC will proceed with their selection process to contract with an artist to complete the work. Staff will update WSRAB on the status.
