NOTICE OF DECISION DATE: December 22, 2015

REQUEST: Minor historic design review of a proposal to replace the freight door on the west facade of Amtrak Station at the Southern Pacific Railroad/Freight Depot site, individually listed on the National Register of Historic Places, zoned CG (General Commercial), and located at 500 13th Street SE; 97301; Marion County Assessors Map and Tax Lot number: 073W26CB02402.

APPLICANT: Eric Reed for Oregon Dept. of Transportation (ODOT)

LOCATION: 500 13th Street SE, Salem OR 97301

CRITERIA: Salem Revised Code (SRC) Chapter 230.060 (c)

Standards for Historic Contributing Buildings in Public Historic Districts

and Individually Listed Public Historic Resources.

DECISION: Based upon the application materials deemed complete on December 21, 2015, and the findings as presented in this report, the application is **APPROVED**.

FINDINGS: The applicant is proposing to replace the existing wooden freight door on the west façade of the Amtrak Building. The door is in poor condition, deteriorated due to dry rot, especially on the bottom edge, allowing both weather and rodents into the building. Staff determined that the following standards from SRC 230 are applicable to this project:

Criteria: 230.060(c) Doors. Replacement of doors in historic contributing buildings shall be allowed only where the owner has attempted to repair the original door, but repair was not feasible due to the poor condition of the original materials. If the doors are not original then every effort shall be made to replicate the original doors; the effort shall be substantiated by historic, physical, or pictorial evidence. If the door cannot be replicated then it should be of a compatible design and material.

(1) Materials. All features of the door shall be replaced with material that duplicate, to the greatest degree possible, the appearance and structural qualities of the original door.

Finding:

The applicant is proposing to replace the wooden door with a new in-kind wood door. The applicant will be restoring the rollers, to ensure that the three panel stile and rail sliding door will continue to function properly.

Staff finds that SRC 230.060(c)(1) has been met for this proposal.

(2) **Design.** The overall design of the door shall reproduce, to the greatest degree possible, the appearance of the original door.

Finding:

The proposed design of the new door matches that of the original door, especially the profile of the distinctive three raised panels at the center of the door. The proposed new door duplicates the appearance and qualities of the original door thereby meeting SRC 230.060(c)(1).

Summary:

The proposed new door is of wood, a traditional material and an in-kind replacement material matching that of the existing door. The proposed new door reproduces, to the greatest degree possible the appearance of the original door and will not adversely affect the building and respects the size, scale, and design of the building, site, and the surrounding neighborhood.

DECISION: Based upon the application materials deemed complete on December 21, 2015, and the findings as presented in this report, the application is **APPROVED**.

The appeal must state where the decision failed to conform to the provisions of the historic preservation ordinance (SRC Chapter 230). The appeal must be filed in duplicate with the City of Salem Planning Division. The appeal fee must be paid at the time of filing. If the appeal is untimely and/or lacks the proper fee, the appeal will be rejected. The Salem Historic Landmarks Commission will review the appeal at a public hearing. After the hearing, the Historic Landmarks Commission may amend, rescind, or affirm the action, or refer the matter to staff for additional information.









