

The regular meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m. on Tuesday, March 20, 2018, at the First Christian Church at 685 Marion Street NE, Salem. Bruce Hoffman, in addition to his regular duties as Chair, also acted as Secretary.

The minutes of the February meeting were approved by unanimous consent.

Councilor Kaser was chairing the third meeting of the <u>Downtown Homeless Solutions Task</u> <u>Force</u> and unable to attend along with board member Neal Kern, who is representing CANDO on the task force.

In public comment, incumbent Salem Municipal Court Judge candidate Jane Aiken offered remarks about her <u>five-year strategic plan for the court</u>, Steve Evans spoke about weekend service and student bus passes being considered at an <u>upcoming meeting of the Cherriots Board</u>, and Marion County Circuit Court Judge candidate Anthony Behrens <u>spoke about his qualifications</u> for the position. Following the presentation on the school bond measure, Melissa Parker offered remarks <u>in support of her candidacy</u> for the office of Salem Municipal Court Judge.
