| Discussion | <p>Cara’s Report</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Integrate Homeless Task Force Recommendations to be part of council goals. Include solutions to partnerships, toilet, & storage. • Budgeting needs to be part of a sustainable funding method to maintain working capital reserve. Will be developing this in work sessions. • Programs to maintain: HRAC (Homeless Rental System) – add another million to house 100 of most difficult to house. Have reached benchmark 2018 with 109 application and 100 housed. • Water upgrades for Ozone and infrastructure upgrades can be done with set aside funds. Will not need a bond for improvements. • Plastic Bag Ban is integrating Councilor’s Cooks proposal to not have the 5 cent pass through on retailers who are already complying. • 11/28 – review Councilor Lewis response to the LUBA decision which remanded the 3rd bridge to the city of Salem to resolve. Kaser says not in favor of the bridge. • Warming shelters to open when nights predicted to be 32 Degrees. • Events: 11/30 Tree Lighting; 12/5 OUR Salem Public Workshop community Input - Court Street Christian Church • Chamber of Commerce received permission from City of Salem to apply for grants for airport service but city will not be the developing party. Grants are currently on hold. |
