	Bad condition of sidewalks in NEN is an ongoing concern. Alan requested more information from the city on prioritizing repairs since current plan not updated since 2014. City's response was that Alan should file a public records request for the Director's Administrative Rules and ADA sidewalk guidelines, which he did. Nancy: Tom Bradley said that city won't replace 5 of the 11 trees removed in sidewalk repair along Chemeketa because 5' planting strip isn't wide enough.
6. Committee and Treasurer Reports	Tree Committee. Lynn: School District wants to replace a module classroom at Englewood School; based on proposed location, construction might affect oak trees in the park.
