## Board Minutes for Northeast Neighbors, NEN

Tuesday, August 10, 2021

Meeting called to order at 6:35 PM by Chair, Lynn Takata.

Action Item: Approval of minutes of July 13, 2021. Approved unanimously by voice vote.

<u>Anthony Gamallo</u>, City of Salem Senior Transportation Planner, presented focusing on the intersection of Market and 15<sup>th</sup>. He reported that intersection is scheduled to be widened and improved within the next two years. This is part of the Capital Improvement Plan (CIP).

Participants commented on the woman in a wheelchair recently killed by a vehicle at that intersection.

<u>Virginia Stapleton</u> gave a report from Salem City Council.

Councilor Stapleton inquired if there is a schedule available for the painting of lines on streets.

She also stated her desire to see improved communication between the City of Salem and the neighborhood associations.

<u>Salem Police</u> <u>Lieutenant Debbie Aguilar</u> discussed police response to the recent report of the gathering of five vehicles all carrying young men wearing the same color shirts and scarves at the intersection of 21<sup>st</sup> street and Kansas NE. A general wide-ranging discussion of possible criminal activity in the area followed, with Lt. Aguilar responding.
