The work will be completed by November 2018. Three flashing pedestrian crossings will be installed. The speed limit is currently 30 mph. Vegetation will be planted along with new street trees, curbs and sidewalks and a sewer main installed. Concerns were expressed by some over cross walk safety.</p> <p>Mark Becktel with the City of Salem listened to ideas on replacing or restoring the Welcome to Salem sign on Portland Road. Hazel volunteered to provide Mark contact information for those originally involved in creating the existing sign. Concerns over insuring the sign is vandal proof and consistent with other signage and improvements in the City were expressed.</p> <p>Bill White provided a detailed summary of options for traffic control measures.</p> <p>Hazel Niles gave the Chair's Report. June 15 is the Bike Rodeo, which will be held at Northgate Park and Hallman Elementary. Pennie reported on attending a neighborhood chairs meeting with the Mayor. She reviewed projects that the group could work on and obtain funding for from the City.</p> <p>Other ideas: Adopt a Street, getting local businesses involved, neighborhood watch.</p> <p>Interest was expressed in having a presentation by Marion County on recent changes to the recycling system.</p> <p>Motion to approve the March and April 2018 minutes was made by Alex Buron and seconded by Leslie Caudillo.
