Update Community Meeting

On Tuesday, April 24, 6 p.m. at Pringle Community Hall, the City will hold the third of three community meetings on the Riverfront Park Master Plan update. After more than 1,600 responses to two community-wide surveys, two community meetings, and three stakeholder advisory meetings, the City will present the preferred concept for the park.
