Committee Reports

Land Use - Paul Lunt expressed concerns about rezoning on Marietta Street Rick Lord spoke to the noise issues on Saddle Club. Ron Sterba addressed the possibility of getting the speed reduced to 45 on Cordon adjacent to Saddle Club. It was suggested that we put an item on the agenda to have a representative from ODOT hear our concerns.

Traffic - traffic is a mess on 12th Street and on Portland Road Transit – new bus stop on Hawthorne north of Mission; on the 20th there will be a christening of the new logo at Keizer Station; they are gearing up for 7 day a week service a year from now. Airport – for August, instrument flights 635, overflights 293, fun flights 2650. for a total of 3578. Busy day was 238 flights, There is a 2-day closure for rehab of the runways. Rick Lord stated there was a committee meeting regarding air service -Ron Sterba said there will have to be a plan to entice airlines.
