**Board Elections** 

Unanimous votes were cast for Cory Poole for chairman, Alan Rasmussen for Vice Chairman, and Pat Richter for Secretary. Committee Chairman - Alan Rasmussen, Land Use; Ron Sterba, Traffic/Transit. Mill Creek Watershed Council will be deleted. Parks and Corban University will be left on the agenda.

Committee Reports

Traffic – Chuck Bengtson reported he had sent a letter along with 74 signatures of concerned citizens regarding traffic on Lancaster Drive. He got a letter back saying it would be 2026 before anything could be done. Motion was made, seconded and passed for a traffic count to be done on the S curve of Lancaster, including heavy trucks. Ron Sterba reported that items to be included are safe routes to schools. Transit - Bob Krebs reports 116 days to Saturday service, extended operating hours will start September 3, student fares of \$10 start June 3. Airport Advisory – for April there were 2811 total operations; 542 business flights; 153 over-flights; 2116 fun flights and the busiest day there were 272. Ron will contact the tower supervisor regarding low flying heloicopters.
