Committee Reports

Land Use – new driveway on Deerpark for Corban University; change of zoning on 22nd and Cordon Road; and a property at 4910 Turner Road.

Traffic – there is a sign on 25th and Mission to guide big trucks to I-5; Helicopters over residential areas are a problem and the tower chief will try to do something about them; Ron Sterba spoke at the City Counsel last night in support of Charles Bengston's petition regarding traffic on Lancaster Drive; and trying to get the speed limit changed to 40 mph on Cordon. Transit – 88 days to Saturday service; Youth passes effective June 1; Saturday service September 7; service until 11:00 starts September 3.

Airport Advisory – for the month of May – 422 business flights. 154 fly-bys, 2586 fun flights, for a total of 3162 operations. Busiest day - 192 operations.
