Committee Reports

Airport Advisory – for September the total operations were 3,688, overflights 147, business 675, fun flights 2866, and the busiest day was 217 operations. Mill Creek Watershed Council – Cory Poole checked out the water overflow system.

Traffic = Ron Sterba stated he sent three thank you notes – one to the City Manager and two to the foremen of the crews that eliminated the left turn lane into the National Guard facility on Turner Road. He also stated that he hand delivered a letter to Peter Hernandez regarding the speed along the Lancaster S curves. It will be 2026 before this is addressed.

Transit – Saturday service has started, runs until 11:00 weekdays and until 9:00 on Saturday. There is pressure to realign the South Salem route for getting to the new Amazon Center. There will be Sunday service starting in May.
