Veterans issues were discussed, including veterans not wanting to go into facilities because of the no alcohol or drugs rule; there are no veteran women facilities. It was suggested that we have someone come to discuss veterans issues. Three fatalities were discussed in which someone ran a red light.

Committee Reports

Traffic – On the former mushroom plant there will be 659 single family houses built. Ron Sterba's worry is how those children will get to the schools in the area. His solution is for lottery or powerball winners get to choose where there tax money goes. The K-Mart site has been purchased by Salem Hospital. South Salem Connect has a concern about the Cordon Road overpass. Ron has written a letter regarding the trees blocking the light at Turner Road. Airport Advisory for October there were 637 instrument, 135 overflights. 3263 fun flights, for a total of 4,065. That was 561 more than September, and the busiest day 228 flights.
