Senator Boles

Senator Denyc Boles gave an update on the state's guidelines for dealing with Covid 19.

Homeless

A long and detailed discussion on the homeless since the City Council legalized homeless camping in Cascades Gateway Park and Wallace Marine Park at the onset of the pandemic. Gretchen Bennett with the City of Salem gave the city's view on the homeless, including opening facilities and affordable housing.

Cory stated he will be addressing the issue of the homeless in Cascades Gateway Park on Monday, July 27. Motion was made, seconded and passed that fair and equitable treatment of all Salem property owners and residents be given with regard to homelessness. The functionality of each park must be maintained. Until a solution is found for the homeless camping in Cascades Gateway Park and Wallace Marine Park, provision should be made to allow homeless camping in ALL public parks.

Reimbursement to Ron Sterba

Ron Sterba has done volunteer work at the airport, including two welcoming structures at the entry. Motion was made, seconded and passed to reimburse Ron for his out of pocket expense.

Committee Reports

Land Use – 4910 Turner Road, outpatient clinic in an existing building; 4423 Burright, zone change for medical device production; 1025 Lancaster 500sq ft addition to car dealership; 5730 Culver Drive, phase business park development project; Airport, process to eliminate some walkways within the airport; 3565 Aumsville Highway, zoning application for two buildings; 3125 Ryan Drive, vehicular work to eliminate nine parking places; 4195 Aumsville Highway, application to partition property.

Airport – received FAA funding on April 20 and construction of base ramp completed three weeks ago. A US Coast Guard parked a large plane on the ramp and it was adequate for it. There will be crack sealing at the airport.
