Cory Poole has a meeting scheduled for August 17 with Gretchen Bennett, Church at the Park and the Elks Club trying to establish the south end of Cascades Gateway as a natural area.

Committee Reports

Traffic – several incidents of accidents on Turner Road, Madrona and 25th and in front of the Hertz facility. Ron Sterba is working to get the speed limit changed to at least 40 on 25th in that stretch. There was a fuel spill at the north end of the National Guard facility. Ron Sterba is working with South Salem Connect to get a sidewalk on Turner Road, meeting scheduled for September 27. Airport – total flights – 4,302, business 470, fun 3613. over flights 219, busy day 200. 276 more flights in July from June.
