TOPIC/ISSUE	SUMMARY OF DISCUSSION AND/OR ACTION TAKEN
10:00	Chairman Cory Poole called the meeting to order, 10 present, introductions were made.
Minutes	Motion was made, seconded and passed to accept the minutes from July as written.
Police	No policeman was present but Cory talked about an incident in Paradise Island Park in which a car was stolen and through pictures taken by cameras within the park the person responsible for the theft was found at the homeless camp in Cascades Gateway Park. There soon will be additional cameras in Paradise Island.
Homeless Camps	Cory gave a slide show presentation regarding the homeless in Cascades Gateway Park, Wallace Marine Park and in Portland. The garbage and destruction in the camps is horrible. The camp in Portland is what Cory is lobbying for in Salem. It is tents set up 6 feet apart in a parking area. Dave Macera with Church at the Park Park, said the biggest growing group is single women with children. He said three months of collected data shows 65% signed for food boxes. Those with a vehicle have been notified they are going to be towed if still there after two days. Four hours per day parking is going to be enforced. Cory is meeting with Neighborhood Associations asking for a letter of support regarding keeping the homeless out of the parks.
Committee Reports	Land Use – Amazon wants to be a good neighbor. Traffic/Transit – construction at 25 th and Mission. Ron has contacted Denyc Boyle regarding a Cordon Road bridge over Highway 22. Airport - for September there were 491 business, 89 over flights, 2460 fun, for a total of 3040 flights. Busy day was 259 flights. A C130 Coast Guard plane landed in Salem and it is good to know that in case of “the big one” a plane like that could land.
Old business	Ron Sterba said a tree at the street corner of where you enter Cascades Gateway Park and Walmart needs trimming to expose the street light. He’s been told it is on the list.
