Police	<p>Officer Gill gave us an update on homeless camping in Cascades Gateway Park from a police standpoint.</p>
Homeless	<p>Nothing has changed in Cascades Gateway Park – gang activity is increasing, evidence of weapons, encouraged not to walk in the park. Gretchen Bennett states cleanup starts June 10.</p>
City Councilor	<p>Tom Andersen gave us an update by Zoom on the homeless in Cascades Gateway Park from the Council’s viewpoint. He stated that in the budget there is money for housing the homeless. He is meeting with the City Manager tomorrow and Cory asked about a city wide website for a census of the homeless and asked about empty parking lots to setup small villages for the homeless.</p>
Sundial Park	<p>Jim Ryan with Commonwealth Real Estate stated that the new owners of Sundial Mobile Home Park are planning a 10 acre parcel expansion of an undeveloped area to provide space for 15 new homes.</p>
Committee Reports	<p>Land Use – Starbucks on Mission. Aumsville Highway – new driveway for Fedex. 5260 Gaffin Road – school district bus depot. 1610 Lancaster - 2 story apartment complex. Costco site - applied for a zone change. Our Salem – massive rezoning of the whole city.</p>
Urban Development	<p>Tory Banford, City of Salem Urban Development Department, stated a pending land use action; subdivision modification on city owned property, Salem business campus, to decrease development to protect wetlands. 5730 Culver Drive, S.E.</p>
