### City Counselor Report by Sally Cook—

\*\*She is reviewing the Next Door Site for issues, where she found issues related to cutting down oak trees.

\*\*She has been working with code-compliance and Urban Development with some ongoing issues related to the allowing the use alcohol at two of the city parks.

\*\*Park with Officer at Minto Brown Park event for watching birds is next Saturday.

\*\*The status of the city water is a big issue and has generated much discussion.

\*\*Issues related on connections with senior services to provide information were discussed.

\*\* Ms. Cook is exploring the city becoming connected grants about traffic and roads.

### City Manager Report by Steve Powers

\*\*The city water is safe to drink for normal risk individuals.

\*\*This year is the 1<sup>st</sup> year in 30 years that a toxin has shown up on the water system.

\*\*Discussion occurred about various aspects of the current testing and treatment of the water given the current situation. The expense related to these activities is manageable.

\*\*More information is available on the city website.

### Glenn Davis gave a storm water presentation.

\*\*He gave an overview of the process of updating the flood maps, emphasizing the study that was complete in Turner.

\*\*The Stormwater Master Plan is updated with the new maps.

### Land Use—No Report

#### Neighborhood Parks—Bill Kelly

\*\*The shelter is up and available for use at Sunnyslope Park. There are three ADA picnic tables, but they are not attached to the structure and are being moved by people using the park.

\*\*Some discussion occurred about have the picnic tables attached.

\*\*The master plan for Secor Park may be coming in the Fall.

#### Sunnyslope Garden—Norm

\*\*The garden has no power.

\*\*They use an electric mower to mow the lawn, as do not feel a gas mower is safe. However, the electric mower is not working. They have talked to another community group to raise funds to replace the electric mower.

\*\*They are working on plan to expand the water line and fence, as the garden is at full capacity.
